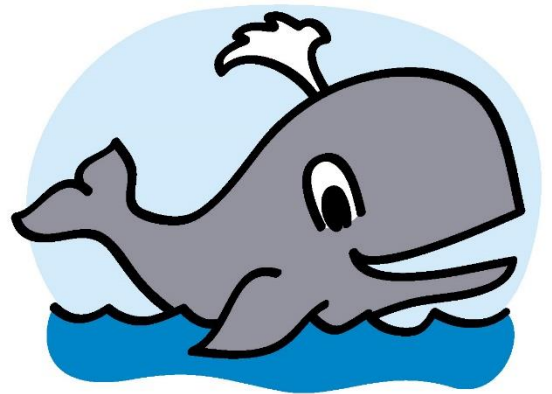
HOOKED ON DANGER
