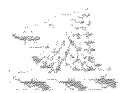
## Junior Tabloid Sports Friday 8 March

## **OLD BOYS JUNIOR NETBALL 2019**

Welcome to the 2019 netball season. Your child has shown an interest to play netball this season. As always we struggle to get coaches for teams, so this year the committee have decided to subsidise your child's subs if a parent/guardian coaches or manages a team. If you do decide to coach, you **must** attend a coaching and umpiring workshop, which is very valuable and gives you an understanding in how the Fun Ferns Programme and games are run. If you have already attended a workshop for the year you are coaching then you will not need to attend the workshop.

Last year Mainland Netball increased their fees significantly which was then passed onto the smaller centres within the Mainland Netball region. Even though Netball South Canterbury subsidised the affiliation fees last year they have said the fees will be increased yearly.
