Bike – Run

This is at a time when fewer of our students are participating in sport either through school or club teams. I was also dismayed to find a number of our eight and nine year olds who cannot ride a bike! In contrast to this are results from a survey we completed with students last week that showed that just 6% of students didn't personally own a phone, tablet or gaming device. The survey also showed that 36% of students were in front of a screen for over four hours a day during a school week and outside of school hours.

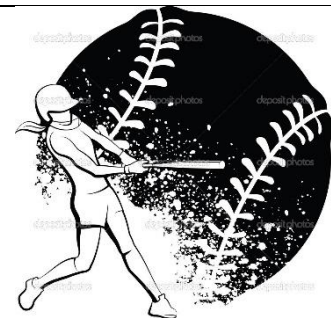
